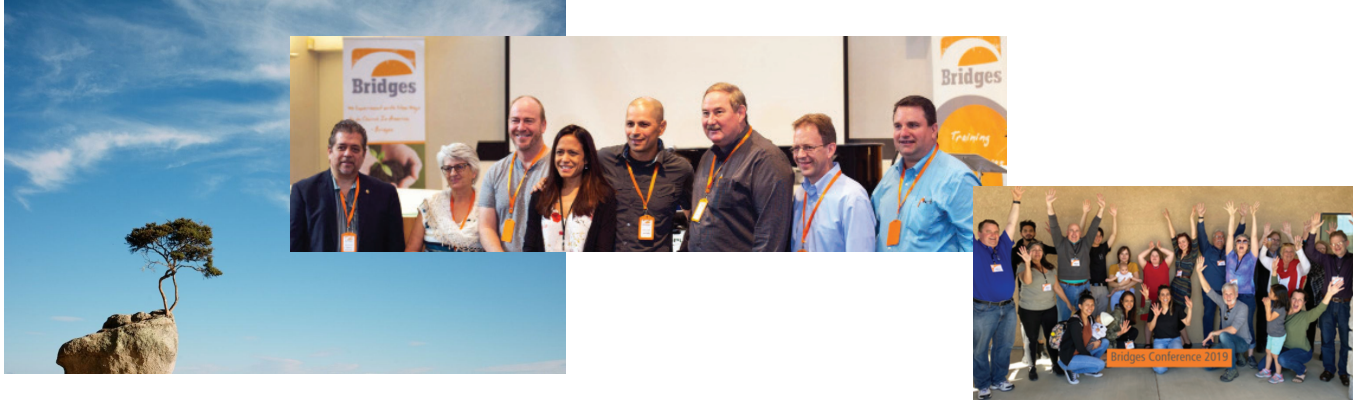


ABOUT BRIDGES

ACTS SERVICES

A- Assessments:
Our assessments help evaluate real progress, identify strengths and weaknesses, and determine the next step in a Bridge Leader’s journey.

C-Coaching:
Coaching is personal help when you need it most. Our trained coaches walk with Bridge Leaders through every step of their journey, asking powerful questions and helping discover creative new paths.

T-Training:
Bridges goes beyond just suggesting what to do; we help Bridge Leaders learn how to do it. We want to provide them with more than just knowledge, and help develop the skills needed to be successful in their ministry.

S-Support Groups:
None of us can do it alone. We need each other. Bridges Support Groups are created to encourage and assist Bridge Leaders in ways most relevant to their unique situation. In Support Group meetings, we share stories from our recent experiences, reflect on what happened, consult related scriptures, seek God’s guidance in prayer, and create next steps for the month ahead.

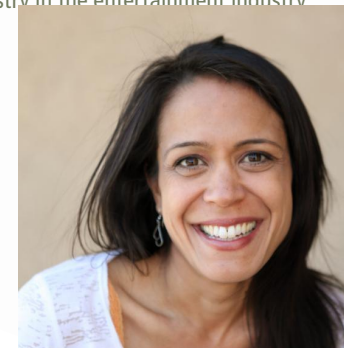

Here's some stories

Maria's Perseverance

It wasn't that long ago that a social worker removed 15-year-old Maria from her home. In order to keep her safe, she was placed in a group home with other teenagers in a distant city. What was a very serious situation could have taken a dark turn. Instead, Maria reached out and called Jim Milley to let him know what had happened.

Through Bridges, Maria secured a seat in an online Website building class taught by Bridge Leader Mike Veerman. She was a stellar student — so much so, that Mike hired her to help him teach the next class of young people. Now Maria works for Hope IT (when she's not making straight A's in school). She also started taking classes at a local college during her senior year in high school. This August, Mike asked Maria to use Zoom to teach computer skills to a class of students in Liberia. When Maria wrote to accept the challenge, she shared, "It's heartbreaking that they do not have the same opportunities as us. If we can help out in any way, I'm sure it'll mean the world to them."



Maria's story is an example of resilience, hope and God's mercy coming to bear through a committed Bridge Leader.

Maria experienced new life, relationships and renewed hope. She went from receiving the help of others to providing help to others. We are grateful for leaders like Mike, who

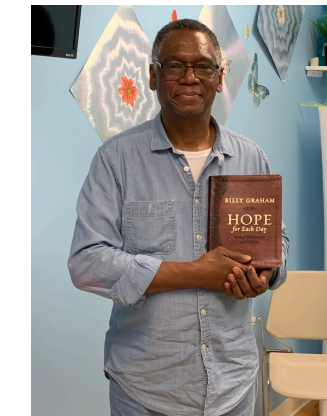

New Church in New York State

During Covid, it sometimes seems like the church across America is not doing well. A bright spot for me was getting to see the new churches that God is forming through virtual communities across the United States and the world. I visited new Bridge Leader Brother Preston and Paul in New York. They have gathered a group of business owners looking for hope in an online group aptly called "Men of Hope". Men of all faiths and some of no faith are participating. I joined them personally several times on Zoom from Los Angeles at 5am.

Brothers Paul and Preston are creating a safe and holy space for these men, and these men, in turn, are being honest about their struggles and discovering healing through Jesus. Brothers Paul and Preston each spend an additional 5-10 hours a week in one-on-one, face-to-face meetings, Zoom calls and phone calls with individual men. God is changing lives.

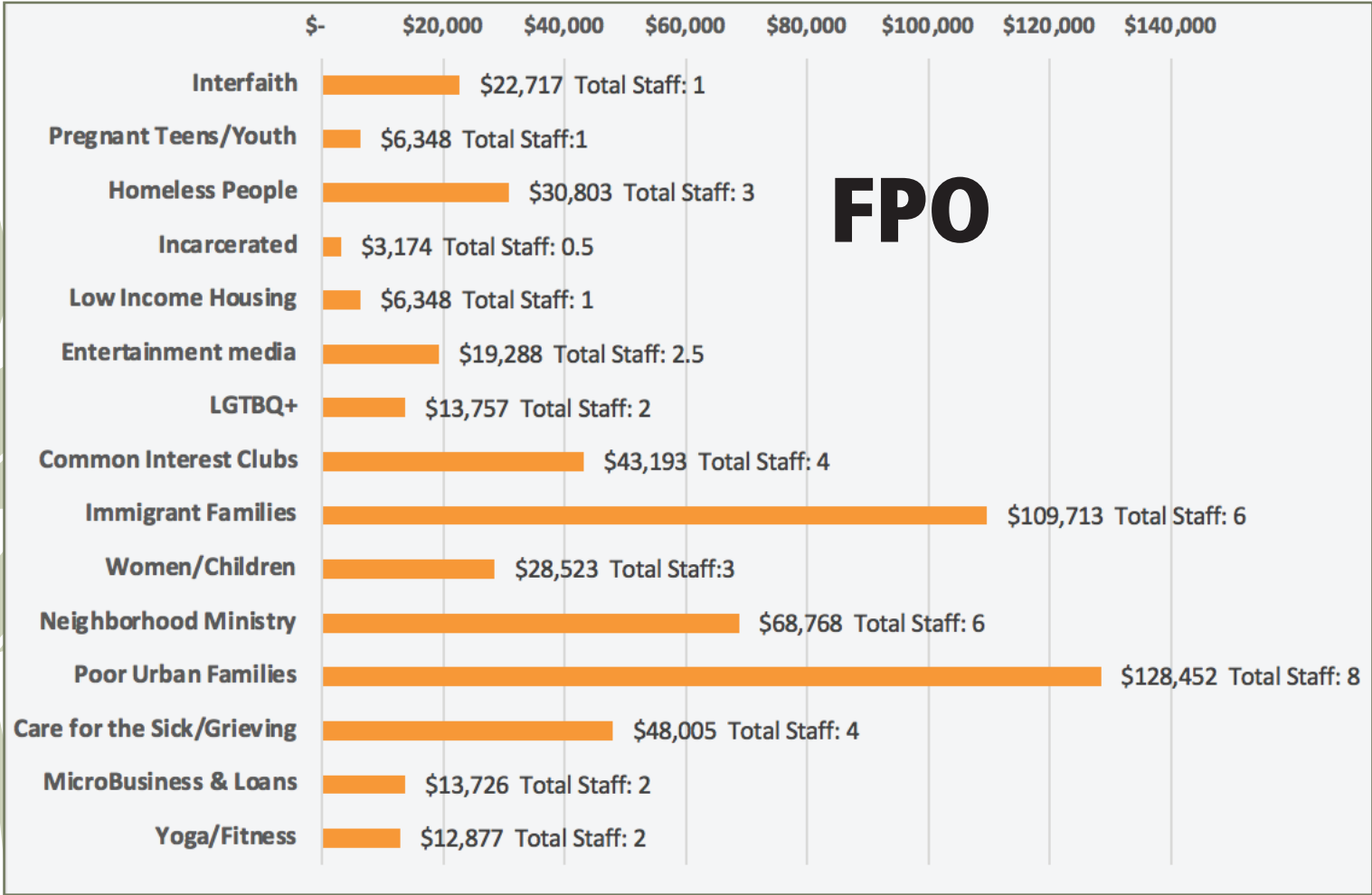
Soon after my visit, Brother Preston called me with an urgent matter. One man was talking about suicide. Brother Preston asked for my advice. "How should I handle this?" he asked. "I am deeply concerned. I don't have a lot of experience dealing with suicide." I was able to share the assessment questions that would enable Brother Preston to discern if he could simply refer the person to a psychologist or if he needed to dial 911 and wait with the person until professional help arrived. And, of course, we prayed- for the young man who was struggling with the darkness. After that, I made a video that I sent to all 47 Bridge Leaders with instructions for responding when people begin talking about suicide.

Here are the causes supported by Bridges, the annual total dollars spent on each cause, and the total Ministry staff per cause over the past fiscal year.

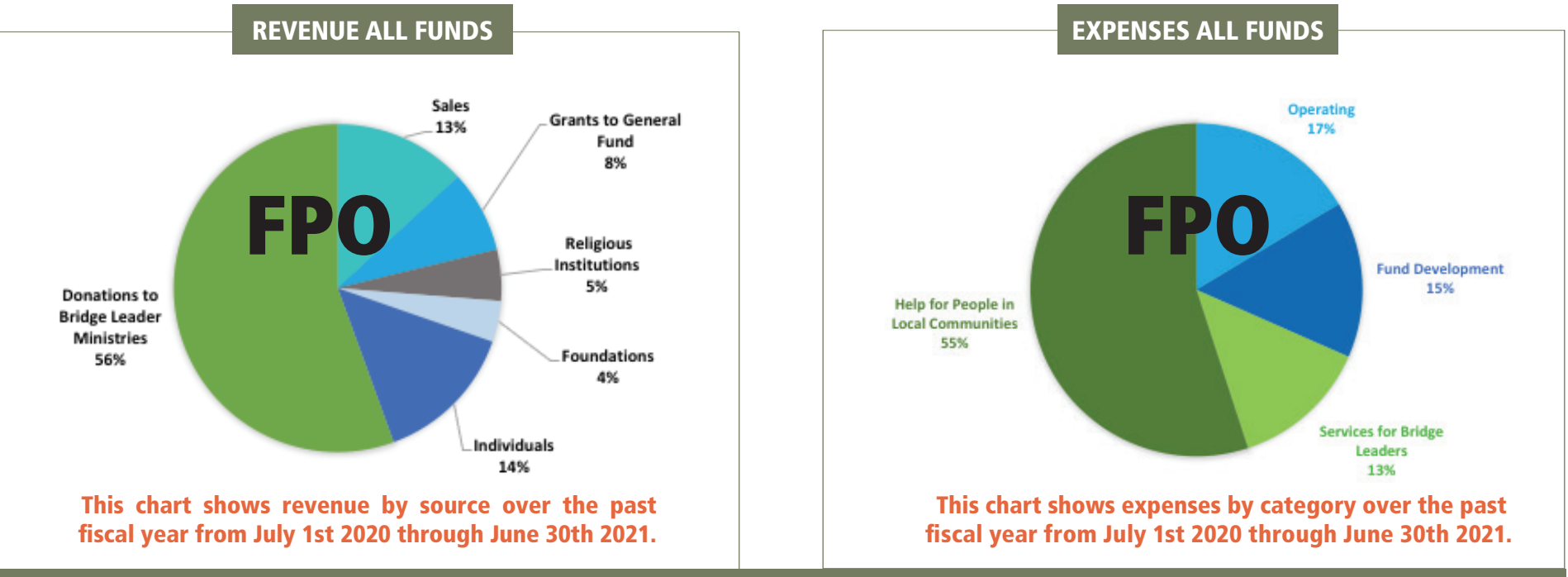

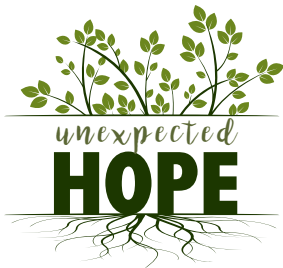

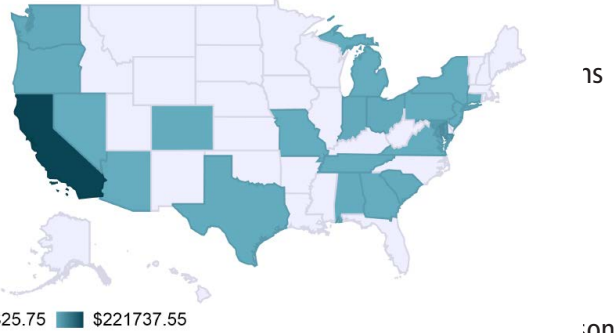
